Thinks they have a lot of money left to "LMCAS Events" and Clubchella may run under budget. Would like to allocate this to "Sponsored Campus Events" Senator Villalobos said that because more students will be registering for next Spring, will they get more money? President McMullen said they receive this money annually President McMullen reminded the senators to keep in mind to be fiscally conservative when offering money to students as LMCAS does have a limit and wishes to avoid another budget deficit Advisor Nguyen clarified that "Bay Adventures" is to bring students to certain places and landmarks for cultural enrichment. Is in the midst of planning such an event but under "Sponsored Campus Events" President McMillen clarified that the Book Rental Program goes toward the Bookstore and Textbooks for Library Reserve go toward the library. Advisor Nguyen stated that he would go through the budget again with Treasurer Mendez for a revised and updated version to go over next week
