The Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) Checklist A Guide to Apply for ACP

Before you apply for the ACP benefit, make sure you have these 3 items:

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#1. Pell Grant Award Letter- you must provide a letter or official document as proof that includes participants first name, last name and an issue date within the last 12 months or a future expiration date. Example: Financial aid award letter.



#2. Identification for Yourself and Your Student

One of the following:

Adult over the age of 18:

Social Security Number (not required)
Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN)
U.S. Driver's License
Other Government-issued ID, such as a state ID
U.S. Military ID
Passport (any country)

Identity documents must contain your first and last name and your date of



#3. You will need a current email address. This is where you will receive updates about your applications and any updates about the program.
