# **2010 Academic Competition Registration Information**

The Academic Competition is a one-day event designed to motivate students to achieve academic excellence at LMC. It is also a fun and interactive way for students to compete academically. Students compete in teams in the following subject areas:

- Mathematics
- Biological and Physical Sciences
- Social Sciences and Humanities
- English

The competition consists of 4 rounds of multiple-choice tests. Students compete in teams of 4 people. Tests are provided by LMC professors who provide the questions for each subject area. The time for each area is 60 minutes and immediately after each round the test answers are evaluated. Points are awarded for correct answers and the teams with the most points at the end of all tests are the winners. The winners of the competition are announced at the end of the event.

The competitors only need to be present at the event. All supplies, test documents, refreshments will be provided by the sponsors.

All students that participate in the Academic Competition will receive a Certificate of Participation and a \$10 gift certificate to the LMCAS Bookstore.

Winning teams will receive the following scholarships (to be divided equally between team members):

- 1<sup>st</sup> Place: \$3,000 (\$750 per person)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: \$2,000 (\$500 per person)
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Place: \$1,000 (\$250 per person)
- 4<sup>th</sup> Place: \$600 (\$150 per person)
- 5<sup>th</sup> Place: \$400 (\$100 per person)

Note: In case of emergency, it is possible to change a member with prior notification by the team organizer.
