LIBRARY DATES & HOURS: June 15th – July 23rd, 8:00 am to 6:45 pm, Monday through Thursday

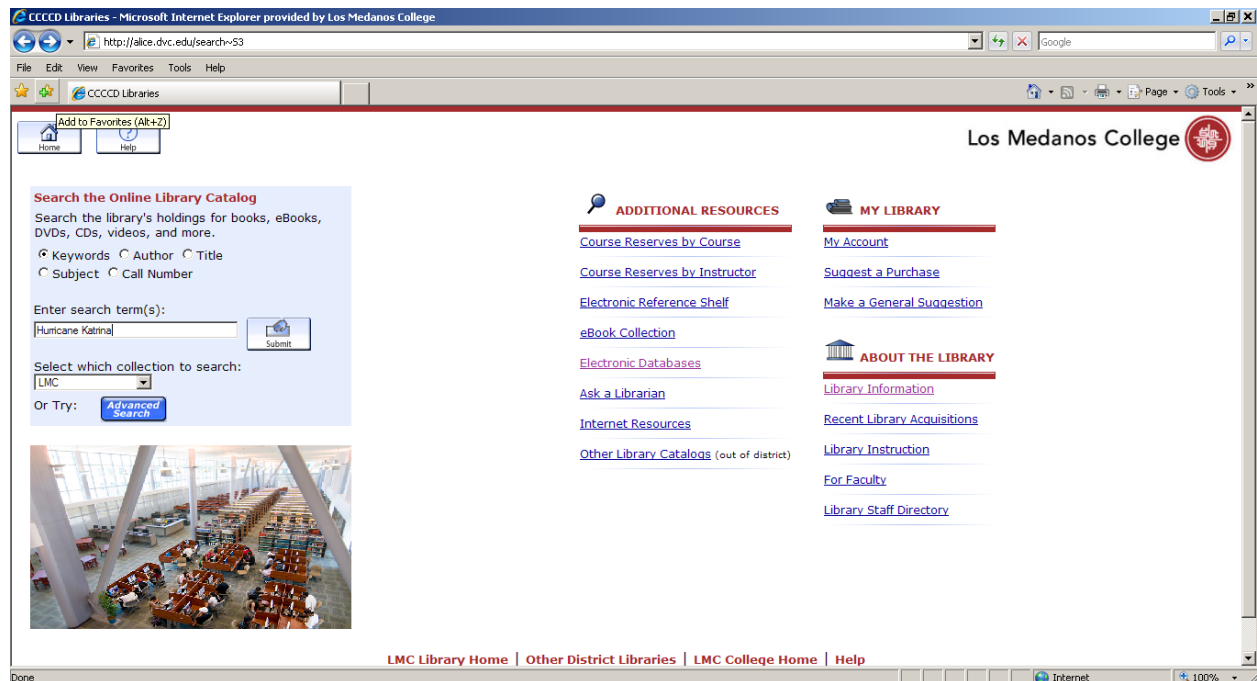
Books requested before 10:00 am, will be available by 11:30 am.
