As we discussed at a recent President's Council meeting, we are re-launching **LMC's Nexus Program for Classified Professionals** in the Spring 2024. We have had a successful semester implementing Equity In Action for Classified Professionals in partnership with Classified Senate and Caring Campus. There is much enthusiasm among employees to engage, learn, and build community.

The Nexus program is designed as a semester-long, cohort experience to onboard new classified employees. At the end of the semester, the participant will be paired with a mentor.
