

2013-14 Resource Allocation Process (RAP) – Revised Timeline (for 2014 -15 funding)

Friday, February 21 **Program Review due** Monday, February 24 Program Maintenance, Program Improvement & Development, Perkins IV and Permanent Classified Staffing proposals, approved by respective managers, due to the LMC Business Office by 5:00 pm. Wednesday, February 26 Business Office submits RAP requests to the expanded President's Cabinet for review. Wednesday, March 5 Expanded President's Cabinet meets to discuss summary of all departments' Program Maintenance, Program Improvement & Development, Perkins IV and Permanent Classified Staffing proposals. From this review, the Cabinet will identify any additional information required for Presidential and Shared Governance Council (SGC) review. Wednesday, March 5 -Tuesday, March 11 Representatives from President's Cabinet coordinate obtaining additional information for proposals, as identified by the expanded Cabinet, and submit information to the Business Office. Wednesday, March 12 Business Office sends: Program Improvement & Development and Permanent Classified Staffing proposals to the Shared Governance Council: additional Perkins IV information to the Dean of CTE & Social Sciences; and additional information for Program Maintenance proposals to the President. CTE Committee meets to review Perkins IV proposals. Tuesday, March 25 Shared Governance Council meets for the first time to discuss Wednesday, March 26 Program Improvement & Development and Permanent Classified Staffing proposals. Designated managers (along with proposers) present proposals to SGC.

If necessary, Shared Governance Council meets for the

second time to discuss Program Improvement & Development and Permanent Classified Staffing proposals. Designated managers (along with proposers) present proposals to SGC.

to the President.

Thursday, April 23 May 8 President provides funding decisions for Perkins IV and one-

time Program Maintenance, Program Improvement &

Development and Permanent Classified Staffing proposals to

the Shared Governance Council.

Friday, April 25 May 9 President notifies campus community of results for Perkins IV,

Program Maintenance, Program Improvement & Development

and Permanent Classified Staffing proposals.

By September 30 President notifies campus community of any additional funding

approvals resulting from available funds identified after the

adoption of the 2014-15 budget.
