**Year 2 - 3**

- Fall 2012
  - 1 counseling appointment each semester

- Lasts for 1 semester
  - If completed and all reg. req., back in good standing
  - If not completed, dropped – appeal?
- Probation Plan
  - If minor, letter with make-up/corrective requirements (i.e. missed trip, missed 1 counseling appointment)
  - If major
    - Meet with Scary Dave
    - Meet with Frances to develop plan
    - Dave approves (possible additional meeting)
    - Checklist style with narrative
