Explanation of Failure to Register for Selective Service

All males, between the ages of 18 and 25 must register with Selective Service. Your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) application indicates you failed to register for Selective Service. To be considered for federal student aid, please complete the following:

- 1. Contact Selective Service at 847-688-6888 to request a Status Information Letter. Attach your Selective Service Status Information Letter to this form and submit both to the Financial Aid Office for Review.
- 2. Explain in detail below, why you did not register.
- 3. Provide supporting documentation regarding your extenuating circumstances for failure to register with Selective Services.

Exemptions: If the following applies to you, you may be exempt from the requirement to register:

- Males currently in the armed services and on active duty
- Males who are not yet 18 at the time that they complete their FAFSA application
- Males born before 1960
- Citizens of the Republic of Palau, the Republic of the Marshall Islands or the Federated States of Micronesia.
- Noncitizens who first entered the U.S. after they turned 26
- Noncitizens who entered the U.S. as lawful nonimmigrants on a valid visa and remained in the U.S. on the terms of that visa until after they turned 26
- Transgender males who were assigned the sex of female at birth

Please be advised that supporting documentation will be requested regarding your extenuating circumstances to any of the above indicated circumstances.
