DESCRIPTION: This course provides the student with the knowledge and skills to safely perform, under minimal supervision, essential and advanced fireground tasks, basic rescue operations, basic fire prevention and fire investigation tasks; and to use, inspect, and maintain fire fighting and rescue equipment.
*Certificates in addition to LMC Fire Fighter I course completion may include:
S-130/190 – Basic Wildland Fire Fighting; CSTI Hazardous Materials, FRO; Auto Extrication; Fire Control 4A & 4B – Flammable Liquids, ICS 200, Rapid Intervention Crew Tactics, Combined Space Awareness.

PREREQUISITES:

1. Completion of no less than 9 units in Fire Technology with grade “C” or better.
2. Completion of Emergency Medical Services 10 (EMT-1) with grade “C” or better.
3. Proof of medical clearance to participate in rigorous firefighter training program.
4. Proof of successful completion of Candidate Physical Ability Test (CPAT), or the equivalent, FIRE 106, within the last 18 months, or co-enrollment in FIRE 106.
5. Prior military experience as a firefighter may exempt a candidate from some prerequisites.

SAFETY EQUIPMENT:

1. Firefighter Personal Protective Equipment will be available for a rental fee.
2. Students are required to provide certain safety equipment (goggles, gloves and flash hood) per specifications provided by college.

REGISTRATION: Complete the attached application form and return with proof of satisfaction of prerequisites to **Los Medanos College, Office of Instruction, 2700 E. Leland Rd., Pittsburg, CA 94565. Applications must be received no later than 5 p.m. on Monday, June 6, 2011.** Applications will be reviewed by the LMC Fire staff. Qualified applicants will be contacted regarding the competitive selection process. Notification of acceptance into the Academy is scheduled to be completed by July 16, 2011.
