



# INSIGHTS

## Headcount Enrollment Highlights (As of Census 4<sup>th</sup> Week Enrollment)

- An increase of 3.5% in overall student enrollment was experienced from Spring 1998 to Spring 1999.
- There has been a steady increase of FTES in the last five academic years.
- The proportion of students from the service area has increased from 71% to 79% in the last five years.
- First-time freshmen have increased from 16% in 1995 to 21% in 1999.
- Most students continue to be part time (80%).
- The percentage of students 19 years or younger have increased from 18% in 1995 to 21% in 1999.
- Enrollment by gender has remained constant at 60% female 40% male.

Figure 1. Overall Enrollment by Headcount

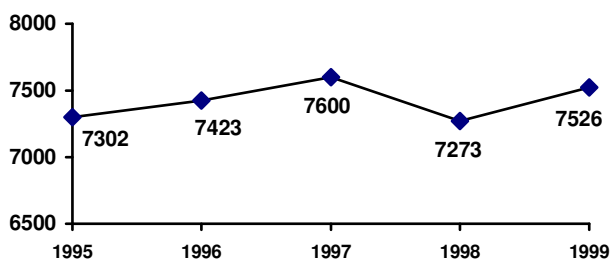


Figure 2. Full Time Equivalent Students  
Residents only

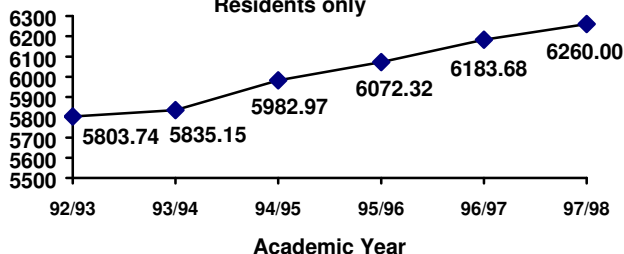

Figure 3. Spring Enrollment Trends by Service Area

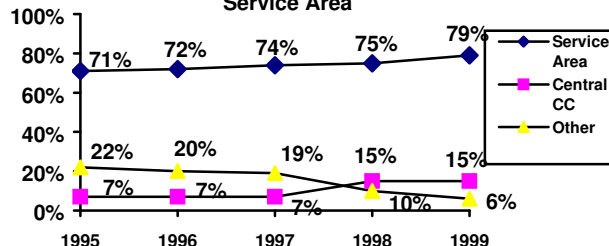

Figure 4. Spring Enrollment Trends by Time Commitment

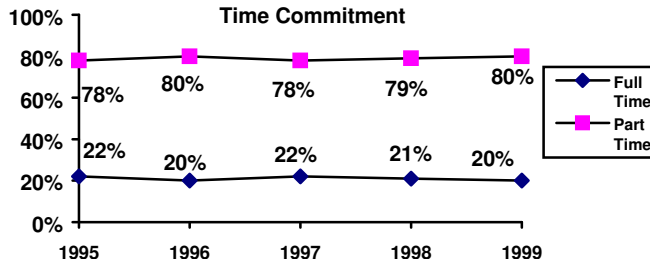
