  - 331 respondents (198 students, 25 classified professionals, 68 faculty, 22 administrators, 18 community)
- Nov. 2019 Feb. 2020: SGC reviewed survey results/themes, developed draft Mission Statements
- March 2, 2020: College Assembly
  - Campus community reviewed drafts, engages in dialogue, provides feedback
  - Also reviewed info about Vision and Values, provided input via group activity
- March 25, 2020: SGC Meeting
  - SGC reviewed/incorporated College Assembly feedback, endorsed proposed Mission Statement
- > April 13, 2020: Senates review proposed Mission Statement
- April/May 2020: Final approval by SGC and Governing Board
