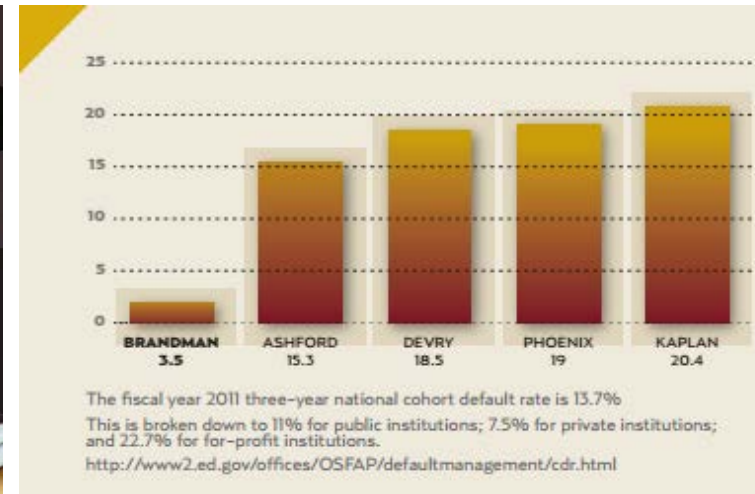
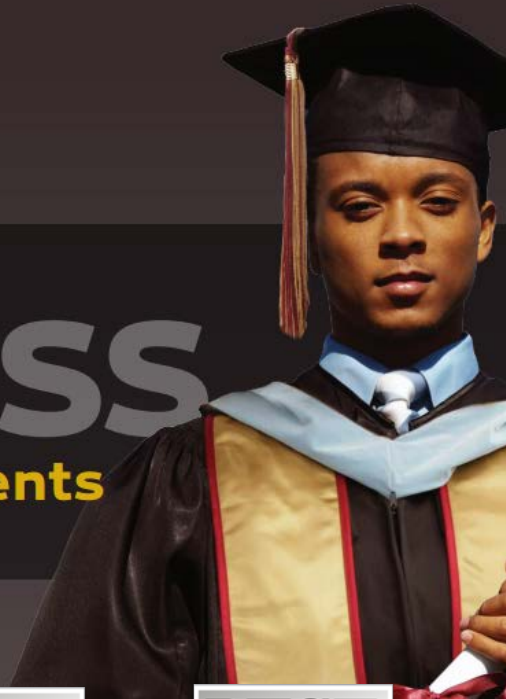

  - 6 credits in elective courses

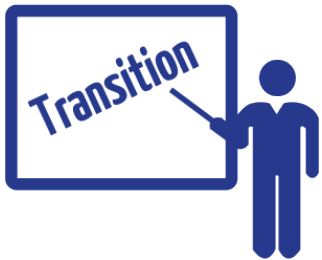

# RN to BSN At-A-Glance

- **Total Credit Hours for the Degree: 120**
  - 68-72 Associate Degree in Nursing credits
  - 16 Prerequisite
  - 36 Upper division nursing in a flexible on-line format
- **Program completed in one or two years**
  - 6 credit hours (2 courses) per term, for six 8-week terms
  - 3 credit hours (1 course) per term, for six 8-week terms
- **Two entry points**
  - Spring I (January)
  - Fall I (September)



# RN to BSN Program Delivery

- **RN to BSN Immersion**
  - One 4-day immersion at the beginning of the program
  - Immersion sessions are held at the Brandman University Irvine Campus
  - Connect with faculty and cohort face-to-face
  - Orientation to Brandman and digital platforms
  - Preview learning theory and practice
  
- **Practicum Experience**
  - Mentored leadership clinical practicum
  
- **Self-directed Study**
  - Online lectures, discussions, social networking, demonstrations, tutorials, readings, scholarly projects and papers



# BSN Admission Requirements

- Associate Degree in Nursing from a CCNE or NLNAC/ACEN accredited program with a cumulative GPA of 2.0
- Grade of “C” or better in all 5 prerequisite courses
- Unencumbered license in the state that you are practicing in (\*or date for NCLEX scheduled before nursing classes start)
- Official transcripts from ALL colleges and universities attended
- Three (3) references and a self-evaluation
- Professional Goal Statement
