

This is broken down to 11% for public institutions; 7.5% for private institutions; and 22.7% for for-profit institutions.



- 48 Credit Degree
  - 33 credits in core courses
  - 9 credits in field Practicum
  - 6 credits in elective courses
- Practicum is a total of 400 hours
- All undergraduate degrees must complete a minimum of 120 total credits in order to graduate.








## **Doctoral Degree Program Mission**

## An Interdisciplinary Degree

- ≥ 57 credits (students are block registered)
  - 2016-2016 Tuition was \$985 per credit for a total tuition cost of \$56,145 \*
  - Scholarships may be available!
- Complete course work in 2 years
  - 11 content
  - 10 research
- **Cohort Meetings**
- ▲ Transformational change project
  - Start in year 1, implement in year 2

## RN to BSN At-A-Glance



- Total Credit Hours for the Degree: 120
  - 68-72 Associate Degree in Nursing credits
  - 16 Prerequisite
  - 36 Upper division nursing in a flexible on-line format
- Program completed in one or two years
  - 6 credit hours (2 courses) per term, for six 8-week terms
  - 3 credit hours (1 course) per term, for six 8-week terms
- Two entry points
  - Spring I (January)
  - Fall I (September)



### RN to BSN Program Delivery



#### RN to BSN Immersion

- One 4-day immersion at the beginning of the program
- Immersion sessions are held at the Brandman University Irvine Campus
- Connect with faculty and cohort face-to-face
- Orientation to Brandman and digital platforms
- Preview learning theory and practice

- Associate Degree in Nursing from a CCNE or NLNAC/ACEN accredited program with a cumulative GPA of 2.0

- Official transcripts from ALL colleges and universities attended
- Three (3) references and a self-evaluation
- Professional Goal Statement
