SMOKING POLICY

POLICY STATEMENT

As required by state statute, smoking is prohibited in all enclosed places of employment in order to reduce employee exposure to environmental tobacco smoke.

SMOKING ON COLLEGE PREMISES

As required by state statute, smoking is prohibited in all enclosed places of employment in order to reduce employee exposure to environmental tobacco smoke.

The College Presidents may establish rules and regulations permitting smoking on college premises, provided that such rules and regulations shall not permit students to smoke in any classroom or other enclosed facility which any student is required to occupy or which is customarily occupied by nonsmoking students.

SMOKING POLICY

No Smoking/Smoking areas may be designated by posted signs in accordance with college/District ordinance requirements

Smoking on College/District Premises

The Chancellor or College Presidents may establish rules and regulations permitting or restricting smoking on college/District premises, provided that such rules and regulations shall not permit smoking within a minimum of 20 feet of a main exit, entrance, or operable window of any college buildings. Smoking is prohibited inside any indoor area of any college building, except for covered parking lots and residential space.

Smoking is prohibited in any enclosed place of employment on District sites, including lobbies, lounges, waiting areas, stairwells, and restrooms that are a structural part of any building that is a place of employment.
