In order for the links to work, you will need to use the "persistent link" which includes LMC's proxy information. This allows remote users access to view library resources. - 2. Click on Course Materials pull down menu.
- 3. Click on Links.



- 4. Select or create a new category for where you want your link to go.
- 5. Type in a Title for your link.
- 6. Paste the URL from the Library resource.
- 7. Click Preview to make sure it works.
- 8. Be sure to leave the open in new window box checked.
