D2L/McGraw Hill - Adding the External Learning Tool: McGraw-Hill Campus LTI

- Step 1: Login to Desire2Learn and access the class you wish to link content to.
- Step 2: Click on Course Materials (Resources in D2L, ver. 10.2), and choose Course Builder.
- Step 3: Add a New Html file from the Add Content area on left side. **Do Not Create a Link.**
- Step 4: Within the New Html file and under the Content heading, click on the insert hyperlink icon within the html editor.

Step 5: Within Type, choose External Learning Tools, and then choose McGraw-Hill Campus (LTI) from the second drop-down menu. Choose your link caption.

<u>Important last step</u>: <u>Choose New Window</u> and then click insert. If you do not choose new window, the McGraw hill access will open in an iframe and the site will only work one time...and then you/your students will need their access codes reset each time you access the course. So, choose New Window, and then click Create.
