

D2L/McGraw Hill – Adding the External Learning Tool: McGraw-Hill Campus LTI

Step 1: Login to Desire2Learn and access the class you wish to link content to.

Step 2: Click on Course Materials (Resources in D2L, ver. 10.2), and choose Course Builder.

Step 3: Add a New Html file from the Add Content area on left side. **Do Not Create a Link.**

Step 4: Within the New Html file and under the Content heading, click on the insert hyperlink icon

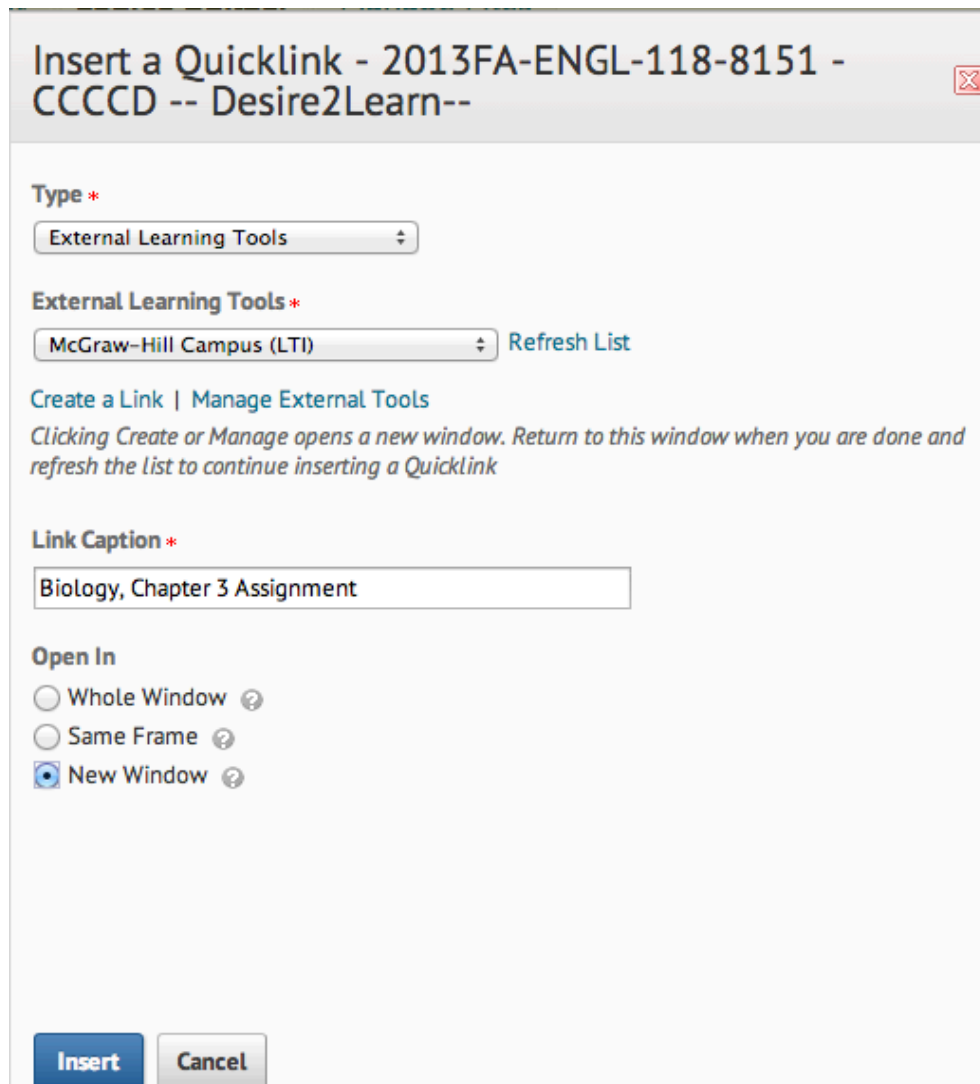


within the html editor.

Step 5: Within Type, choose External Learning Tools, and then choose McGraw-Hill Campus (LTI) from the second drop-down menu. Choose your link caption.

Important last step: Choose New Window and then click insert. If you do not choose new window, the McGraw hill access will open in an iframe and the site will only work one time...and then you/your students will need their access codes reset each time you access the course. So, choose New Window, and then click Create.
