# **LMC Foundation Scholarships – Frequently Asked Questions**

### What are the eligibility requirements?

To be considered for an LMC scholarship you must:

- ✓ Be currently enrolled at LMC for both the fall and spring semesters
- ✓ Have a established a minimum GPA of 2.0 at LMC
- ✓ The additional criteria for each scholarship opportunity varies and may include financial need, declaration of a particular major, community service, and/or other requirements.

### What are the application requirements?

- ✓ **Unofficial Transcript:** You must upload your unofficial LMC transcript as part of the application process.
- ✓ References: You must secure two references from reputable sources (i.e.: instructor, counselor, LMC staff member, coach, employer, mentor, etc.). References from family members, significant others, friends, classmates, etc. Are not considered reputable sources and will not be accepted.
- ✓ Essay: There is an essay component to the application.

# • I am an undocumented student. May I apply?

Yes, as long as you meet the minimum requirements listed above.

### • I am an international student. May I apply?

Yes, as long as you meet the minimum requirements listed above.

#### When do I apply?

The LMC general application period runs yearly November through February.

# Do I need to apply for financial aid (FAFSA/California Dream Act)?

The Scholarship Office strongly encourages students to complete the <u>Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)</u> or <u>California DREAM Act Application</u> each year to determine your eligibility for federal and/or state grants.

# Are there additional eligibility requirements?

The LMC Foundation offers over 40 different scholarship opportunities in which the criteria for each scholarship varies. Criteria varies based on a student's GPA, educational major, career goals, community service, foster youth, veteran status, continuing LMC student, transferring student, etc. Visit, <a href="https://losmedanos.academicworks.com/opportunities">https://losmedanos.academicworks.com/opportunities</a>, for a list of LMC scholarships and eligibility criteria.

#### Do I need to complete an application for each scholarship opportunity?

No. After completing and submitting the general application you will be **auto -matched** and recommended to opportunities:

- ✓ <u>Auto-matched:</u> The auto match feature will automatically match your application with the scholarships for which you meet the minimum eligibility criteria.
- ✓ <u>Recommended Opportunities:</u> These are opportunities that you will be matched to based on your general application but you will need to answer supplemental questions to be considered for the opportunity.

#### Do I need to complete the application in one session?

No. You may start and save your application prior to submission and access the application again.

# How many LMC scholarships can I apply for?

There is no limit to how many you can apply for.

### Is there a limit to how many LMC scholarships I can be awarded?

No.

## What are the LMC scholarship award amounts?

The award amounts vary from \$100 to \$10,000.

# • Can I reapply for LMC scholarships?

Yes, you can reapply for LMC scholarships yearly as long as you continue to meet the minimum eligibility requirements.

### How are students notified of the status of their application?

Applicants are notified of the status of their application via student Insite email in May.
