What is a STEM Student?

An LMC STEM student is defined as a student who is pursuing an associate of science degree or bachelor of science transfer path in one or more of the following calculus-based STEM programs: Biological Sciences, Computer Sciences, Engineering, Mathematical Sciences or Physical Sciences.

You qualify if you:

- Hold U.S. citizenship or lawful national or alien status
- Have successfully completed pre-calculus
- Demonstrate financial need, according to federal guidelines
- Upon selection, enroll full-time (12+ units at LMC) in a program leading to an associate or baccalaureate degree in a STEM discipline
- Upon selection, become an active participant in the STEM Scholars Cohort of the MESA Program.

High school students need:

- A minimum overall GPA of 3.0

LMC students need:

- A minimum overall GPA of 2.7 and have an overall GPA of 3.0 in their STEM classes
- To have completed a signed Student Educational Plan

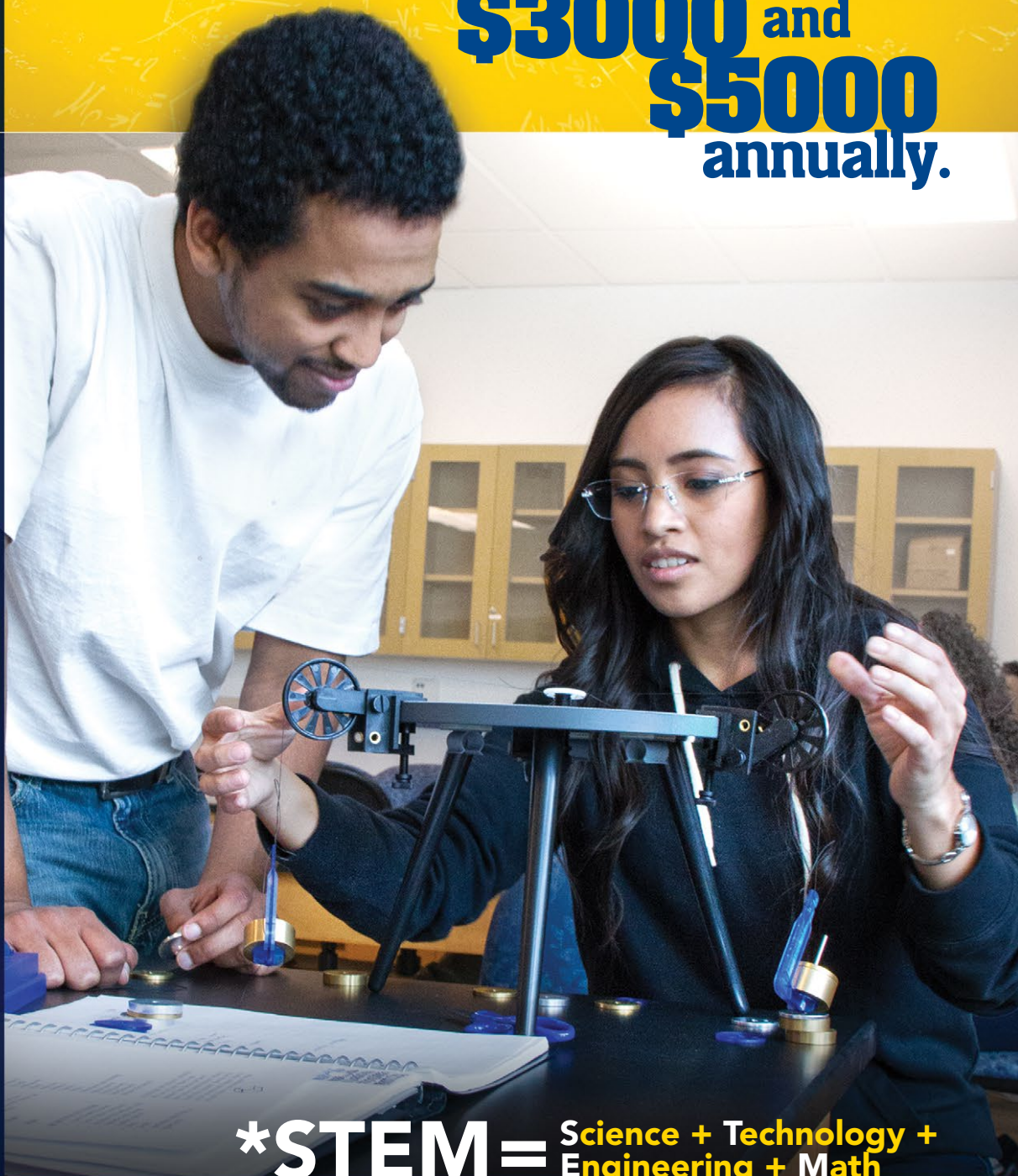
