### PRE-CONFERENCE REQUIREMENTS

This meeting will be held with the staff trip leader and will cover trip conduct expectations, travel and logistics, more about what to expect at the conference, and detailed information about the post-conference requirements.

### **POST-CONFERENCE REQUIREMENTS**

Students attending the LLN Conference will be required to complete 3 activities during the Spring 2015 semester to share their knowledge and experience from the conference. 1) Students will each create a small display board showing what they learned, which will be hung on display during the spring semester. 2) Students will participate in a Lunch Discussion to be hosted the week of April 13-17 with LMC students/staff/faculty to talk about their conference experience and what they learned. 3) Students will create and give a 15-20 min. group presentation on their experience and what they learned to the Puente English-100 class.
