New SPRING 2014 Policy

Peer-to-Peer Mentoring Contact (Limited Services EOPS students only)

Must meet with an EOPS Peer Mentor for 2nd counseling contact between 03/03/2014 to 04/04/2014

Book Voucher Policy

- 1. Use only at LMC Bookstore. Only for current course textbooks. Must bring class schedule and picture ID.
- 2. 1-time use. Expires <u>14</u> days after disbursed.
- 3. If lost, replaced with **police report**.

Parking Policy

Limited service and appeal - NOT eligible.

Counseling Policy

- 1. <u>Children</u> NOT allowed, per Los Medanos College policy.
- 2. Make-up appointments guaranteed Yes___ No $\underline{\mathbf{X}}$
- 3. Drop-ins Yes____ No <u>X</u>
- 4. Late after <u>ten (10) minutes</u> No Admittance
- 5. Three (3) counseling contacts with EOPS counselor

*<u>Exception</u>: Students permitted to meet with non-EOPS counselor can complete 2 of the 3 meetings within EOPS timeline and guidelines.

Email Policy

Students are required to establish, maintain, and consult their **InSite** email (e.g. <u>JDoe123@insite.4cd.edu</u>) weekly. This serves as a contact point for EOPS official communication.

Academic Progress Report (APR)

Student must obtain instructor feedback from **ALL** enrolled courses. And must meet with at least 50% of instructors during office hours to obtain feedback, i.e. student enrolled in 5 courses, meets with 3 instructors during office hours but has **ALL** instructors fill out APR.

Multiple Campus Policy

Majority of units must be taken at LMC. If enrolled in an even number of courses, LMC must be designated as financial "HOME".

Nine (9) Units Policy

- 1. <u>Continuing students</u> successfully completing <u>12 or more</u> units may take <u>9-11.9</u> units in following semester.
- 2. Cannot have less than <u>12 units</u> in <u>consecutive/back-to-back semesters</u>.
- 3. <u>Two (2) semester</u> life-time limit.

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Full-Time Waiver Policy

At the sole discretion of the EOPS director, a limited number of students may be approved to enroll and complete **less than** a fulltime course load. (i.e., 12 units fall or spring, 6 units in the summer)

EOPS Transfer Policy

EOPS supports student transfer to another EOPS program but *cannot guarantee* admission.

Time/Unit Limit Waiver Policy

Full-Service students with high **unit majors** may petition to extend eligibility for EOPS services up to **two (2)** semesters beyond 70 degree-applicable unit/6 semester limit.

Non-Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy

Students showing **poor performance** (i.e. D's or F's) at MSPR deadline are required to meet with EOPS counselor or staff no later than $\underline{two}(2)$ weeks after the MSPR deadline to devise a strategic plan.

Appeal for Readmission Policy

- 1. Students dismissed from EOPS due to back-to-back semesters of **<u>non-compliance</u>** may submit a written request for readmission.
- 2. No second appeals accepted. No appeals for status downgrade permitted.

Eligibility for EOPS Length

- 1. <u>Seventy (70)</u> degree-applicable units.
- 2. <u>Six (6)</u> consecutive semesters (summer excluded).
- 3. Dishonor MRC <u>two (2)</u> consecutive semesters (appeal and application required for readmission).
- 4. **<u>Voluntarily</u> withdraw** from EOPS (reapplication required).
