Additional Info	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Many CSU campuses require that the “Golden Four” be completed by the end of Spring prior to Fall transfer or by the end of Summer prior to Winter/Spring transfer. All UC campuses require completion of required courses by the end of Spring prior to Fall Transfer. • In addition to the courses on this sheet, <i>most</i> CSU/UC campuses require specific <i>major</i> preparation courses be completed prior to transfer. • Please check www.losmedanos.edu/transfer for additional resources • <i>Please see your counselor and check www.assist.org for more details</i> • Check the back of this hand-out for application due dates. 																

When to Apply

UC (University of California)

<i>When to start your TAP:</i>	As soon as possible and on-going
<i>When to apply to TAG:</i>	Fall semester filing period is September 1-30
<i>To begin UC application:</i>	Website opens August 1 st
<i>When to submit UC application:</i>	You must submit between November 1-30

To begin studies during:	You must apply:
Fall Semester or Quarter	October 1 to November 30
Winter Quarter	If open, apply June 1 to 30*
Spring Semester or Quarter	If open, apply August 1 to 30*
Summer Semester/Quarter	If open, apply February 1 to 28*
