



UMOJA SCHOLARS PROGRAM CONTRACT



Umoja Scholars are expected to:

1.	Enroll in the Umoja Scholars classes until completion of academic goals, certificate or transfer-level courses: Math 34 and English 221.
2.	Commit to participating in an intrusive counseling model which requires frequent check-ins outside of the counseling department. Meet with the Umoja Scholars Counselor at least once each semester to discuss educationa and career goals. Keep appointments and notify counselor in advance if there is a dire need to reschedule, or if changes are made to schedule.
3.	Utilize available Student Services: If eligible, apply for Financial Aid by completing the FAFSA, apply for CalWorks and/or EOPS, and DSPS.
4.	Communicate with Umoja Scholars staff and faculty as much as necessary for academic success.
5.	Attend tutoring and study group sessions.
6.	Keep a CURRENT contact number and address on file at ALL times.
7.	Attend at least one college tour per year.
8.	Participate and be actively involved in at least 3 Umoja Scholars Program activities per semester: Events, Community Meetings, Umoja Leadership Collective activities, Workshops, etc
9.	Participate in the Ladder to Success, Mentors Amongst Us, or Peer Mentor Program.
10.	Be your brothers or sisters keeper – keep in contact with Umoja partners.
11.	Uphold the principles of Umoja: UNITY, TOGETHERNESS and RESPECT!
