Armendariz	Dr. Armendariz and Sr. Dean, Ryan Pedersen joined the meeting discussed the development and submission of the new student equity plan, which will span from 2025 to 2028 and focus on improving outcomes for underrepresented student groups. Rosa Armendariz, the Senior Dean for Diversity, Equity, and Belonging, explained the plan's structure, metrics, and alignment with other college planning initiatives. The college identified specific student populations to

			prioritize, including Black and African American students, male students, first-generation students, foster youth, and LGBTQ+ students. The next steps involve reviewing the draft plan with various campus groups, with final approval expected by November for submission to the state. The meeting focused on reviewing student equity plan metrics and data lag issues, with a discussion of the BSSI initiative's impact on Black student success in math and English courses over three years, showing a slight dip in year one followed by improvement in subsequent years. The group reviewed admission and enrollment procedures, particularly focusing on priority enrollment for student government officers, with a need to clarify whether all active members or just officers should receive priority registration. The conversation ended with plans to present more detailed visuals at the next meeting on the 20th, and Robert agreed to send a draft for review beforehand.
