Basic Needs operates out of the LMC Marketplace which is designated as the "MP" building on the Pittsburg LMC Campus Map near the Child Study building. We are located in the brown portable next to the LMC Lake. The LMC Marketplace provides free food, clothing, and hygiene items for LMC students and employees during our hours of operation which are as follows:

CalFresh:

The CalFresh Program, federally known as the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), issues monthly electronic benefits to eligible students that can be used to buy most foods at many markets and food stores.



TimelyCare:

TimelyCare provides 24/7 virtual medical care and mental health services to students free of charge.



Low-Cost Auto Insurance:

California Low-Cost Auto Insurance is a state-sponsored program that provides affordable, liability-only auto insurance that meets the state's financial responsibility laws.
