The COVID-19 Emergency Grant was a one-time \$1000 grant available to Los Medanos College (LMC) students who are facing unexpected expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to coronavirus. Funds can be used to pay for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to the coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care), or child care. Funds received did not need to be repaid.
