Review scope of SB 70 and Transitions-


SB 70 #5 has approximately \$45,000 left to spend out by the end December 2013. SB 70 #6 for \$120,000 has already been awarded but cannot be spent until SB 70 #5 is spent out.

SB 70'S future is 1070. 1070 is putting RFA's together; funds won't be delegated per school but by districts. RFA will allow 2 proposals, NW and SE group.
