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

^{**} DR = Indicates a drop after first census date, but before the date for receiving a "W". A "DR" notation has no academic implications for a student and is not included on the student's transcript. For that reason, the "DR" grade is excluded from most enrollment and success metrics. However, we note that the ARCC report does include "DR" as a valid enrollment indicator.

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Completion Rate Point Gap: is the distance between individual ethnicity completion rate from the average of all the ethnicities combined. For example if x ethnicity has a completion rate of 85% and the average for all the ethnicities is 70% the point gap for x ethnicity is (85% - 70%) = 15%.

Successful Rate Point Gap: is the distance between individual ethnicity successful rate from the average of all the ethnicities combined. For example if x ethnicity has a success rate of 85% and the average for all the ethnicities is 70% the successful rate point gap for x ethnicity is (85% - 70%) = 15%.
