| 5. D2L Training/Support update<br>a. District website   | The District D2L training/support site is now funded through July. District DE Chairs and Debbie Wilson will meet 3/12 to create an action plan. Debbie Wilson and Mario Tejada will be completing the work with input from the DE Chairs of each college. The LMC Distance Ed Committee web pages continue to be updated. Requests for D2L training have abated. | 7. Online Supplement Form revision                      | A draft of the revised online supplement was presented to the GE Committee at their meeting of February 21. They are concerned that the speaking component in an online section needs more detail about how it is conducted and assessed. The consensus of the Distance Education committee was that sufficient detail is contained in the course outline or record and to be detailed beyond that in the online supplement would be overly proscriptive. The DE chairs are still working with the GE Committee to resolve this issue. |
