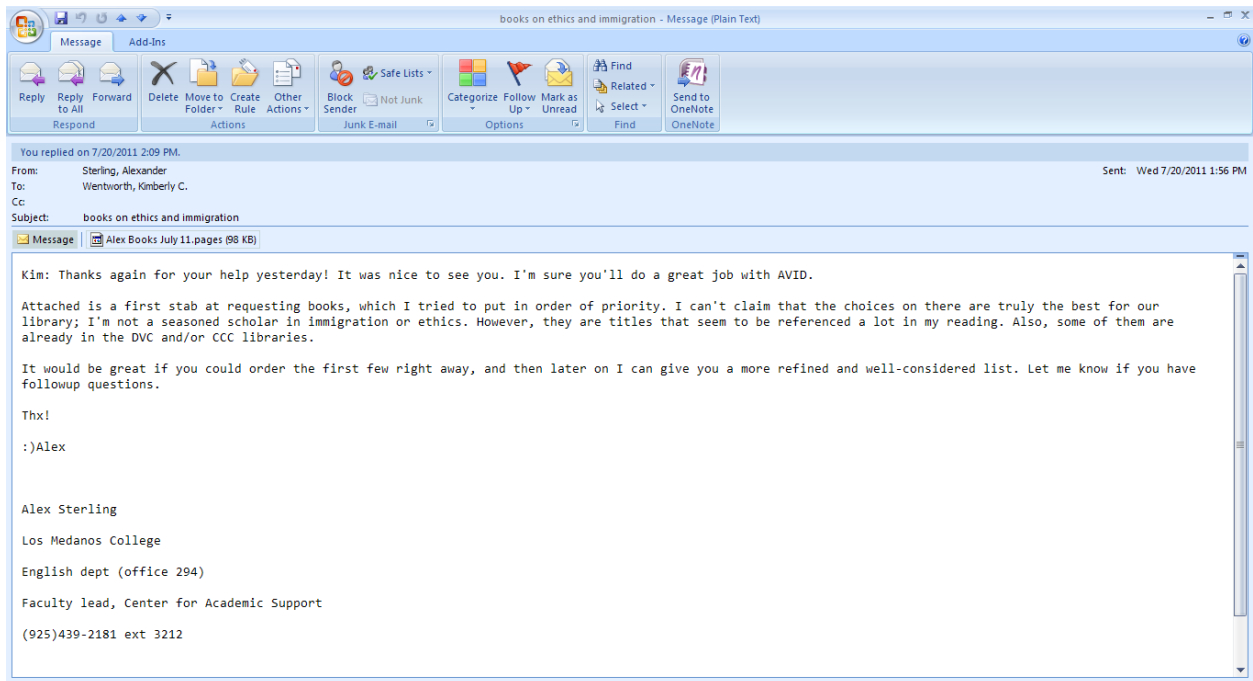

- 7) **PLEASE note:** many, but not all, of the Readers come with an accompanying audio CD that needs to be checked out separately

Could you please send me a list of some sample research questions that your students might search so I can recommend some search strategies? We will try to put together a list of kinesiology related journals that we do have.


