CHDEV 83 is a prerequisite course but may be waived if you have at least 6 months experience in an early childhood setting.

Math 120 fulfills the B4 Math requirement for CSU General Education. Math 120 is the preferred course selection if you want to work in the early childhood field or receive a multiple subject teaching credential. The prerequisite math course for Math 120 is **Math 29 or Math 30**, not Math 27.

Math 120 does not fulfill IGETC math requirements but it does transfer to a UC. For those students planning to transfer into a Psychology or Sociology program Math 34 is a better choice.
