District DE Dashboard

District is working on a new dashboard. There is an existing one in Tableau, which monitors online enrollment and success. The research person at District is working on a more useful dashboard. There is a question about what kind of information the committee would like to add to information gathering.

A member has raised the concern that we would need something to compare the data *to*. An example would be how do asynchronous students compare to success rate of synchronous students, compared to hybrid. It would also be useful to see the success rates and assessment data about badged courses, to give the numbers more meaning. Such data would help identify if badging courses would directly increase student success rate.

A resource member noted that there has been research conducted at campus level already, and those would most likely appear on the dashboard.

Process for approving Canvas Tech Integrations

During the last meeting, the committee discussed having a form for faculty to fill out to request Canvas Tech Integrations. Since then, Erlinda reached out to Ann, a DE Dean at DVC. Ann shared a Microsoft Form they use, called Canvas Service Request.

Resource members noted the cost to students and faculty should be captured.

A resource member mentioned that "Some topics like accounting where students get immediate feedback, it is invaluable"

Orientation Modules and onboarding for Online Classes

For accreditation purposes, based on the outcomes, the DE committee should make recommendations to the college.

Counseling representative should facilitate a conversation about the outcomes related to results of the Student Modality Preference Survey where the newly entered first time students, who just graduated high school, who created an all-online schedule, did not persist.

It would be beneficial to do a FLEX where instructors are supported by DE in making a full orientation module for students to take, so the persistence rate could be measured for courses with a DE badged orientation.

Laurie would love to lead the variable FLEX.

A difference was noted between BEOI and what is being proposed: BEOI does not *require* the students to complete a quiz after completing the orientation module.
