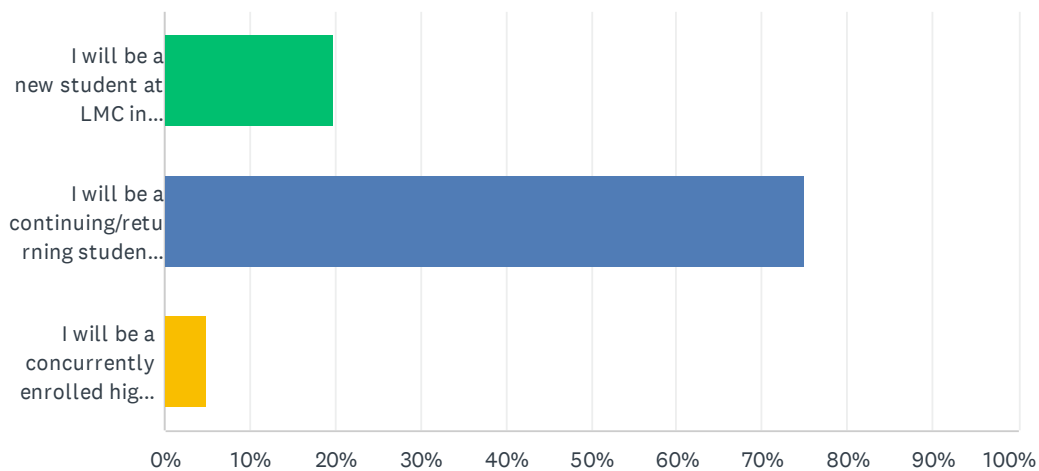


Q1 What type of student are you?

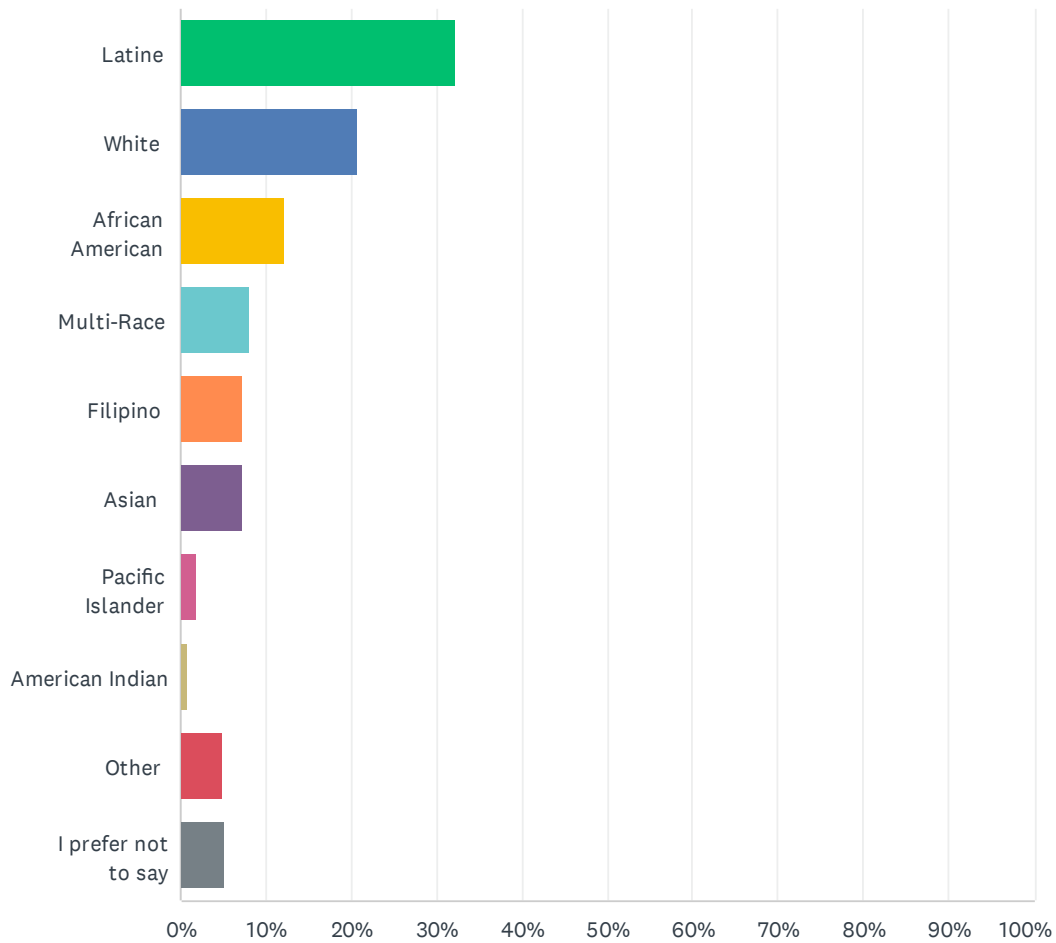

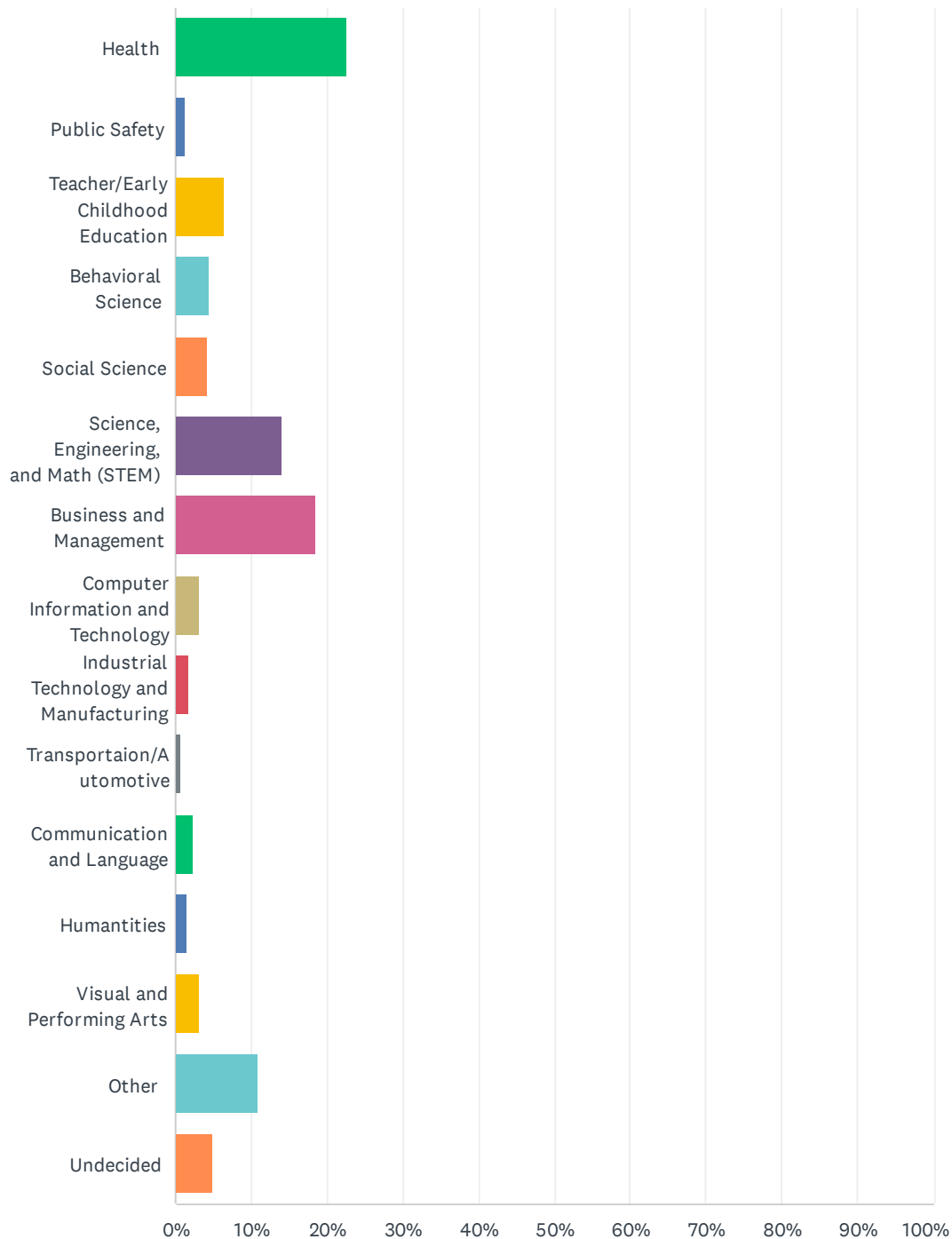

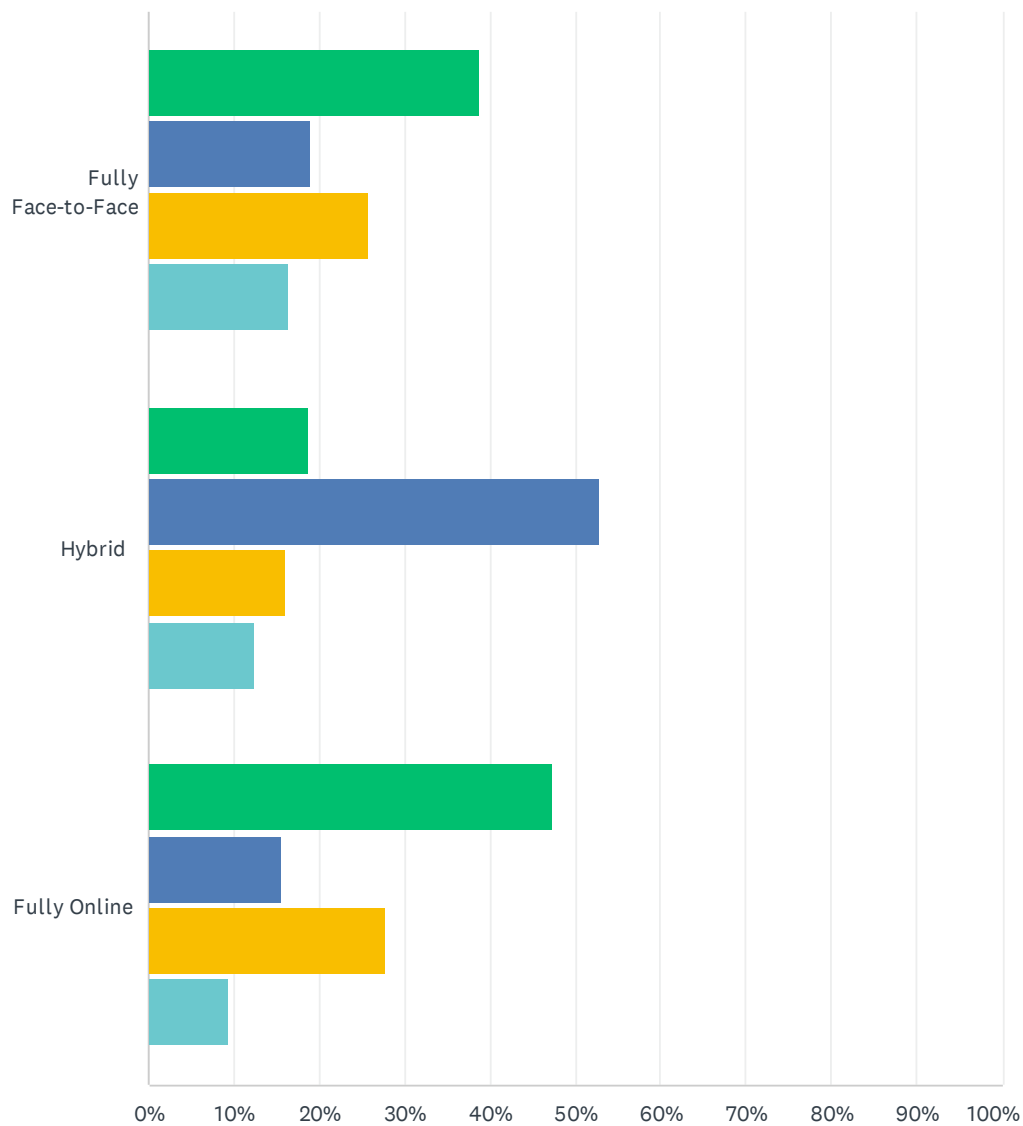
