



Cal-HBCU Transfer Grant Checklist

Before You Transfer

- To get started, meet with your **Community College Counselor**
 - Select your **Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT)**
 - Identify the **Eligible HBCU** for Transfer. The school must be included on the Eligible HBCU List, available on the Cal-HBCU Transfer Grant website: csac.ca.gov/cal-hbcu
- When you are ready to transfer to the HBCU, **file for graduation** (degree) at your California Community College
 - Check for deadlines and any fees
- Submit your FAFSA** (or corresponding state-based financial aid application for students who cannot use the FAFSA application) by the HBCU and/or state's deadline
 - Make sure you list your HBCU on your financial aid application
- Complete your **Cal-HBCU Transfer Grant Application**
- Obtain a copy of your **transcript** once your degree has been posted
- Submit your transcript to the **CCC HBCU Transfer Agreement Program** for Verification of your ADT completion
 - **Please note that the email you provide on the Cal-HBCU Transfer Grant Application will be the primary means of communication.

- Meet with your **HBCU Financial Aid Office**
- Receive your Cal-HBCU Transfer Grant!**
