In attendance: Julie Von Bergen, Rudolf Ryan, Joshua Bearden (via Zoom), Shelly Baird

Purpose of this meeting was to discuss CalPass data metrics to determine top 4 stats to be taken to Pomona for further discussion/prioritization. And based on these stats can we form sub-committees (On-Boarding, Staying on Path) to further our project work?

Determining factors for choosing these four stats were based on the state-wide goal initiatives (AB705, Guided Pathways) in conjunction with our Guided Pathways Focused Flex Data Discussions on 8/23/18.

1. 16% of Students earned 24+ College Credits in Year One
2. 18% of Students earned 12+ College Credits in First Term
3. 36% of Students are Full Time Students (therefore, 64% are part-time)
4. 64% of Students Persisted from Fall Semester to Spring Semester

Discussion:

- Overall, the WHYs behind these stats need to be revealed – need further data
 - Impact of day-to-day life restricting a full-time load
 - Course offerings – schedule (am, pm, fall, spring, summer) limitations/barriers
 - Tuition and Text Book costs
- Tap into District – for possible survey question implementation for better understanding if students got the classes they wanted (after registering online – why or why not)... AND why students dropped a class (after completing the online drop form – reasons for dropping)
 - Scott Hubbard working with District on data
- Can we propose incentives for students to complete 30 units in Year One?
 - More class offerings – calendar & scheduling changes
- Is funding at risk if increases in unit completions fall short of 30?
 - Need to ensure our project work isn't fueled by funding, but by student success goals
- Tap into Skyline
 - Plan Retreat Summit with Equity as the theme allowing for “Guided Pathways 101”
