Why Honors to Honors?

Honors to Honors students in UC Irvine's **Campuswide Honors Collegium (CHC)** benefit from stimulating honors courses, mentorship by top faculty, resume-building research, a supportive and diverse student community, personal academic guidance, priority registration, and close collaboration with peers from all walks of life and majors throughout campus. Honors to Honors students are required to take one CHC class in their first year at UC Irvine, and all CHC students engage in research which is written up as an honors thesis, usually during their final year.

Students also receive consideration for merit-based scholarships.

Honors to Honors does not guarantee admission to UC Irvine. If you are interested in an admissions guarantee, see the TAG information below. Excluded majors from Honors to Honors include those that require an audition or portfolio and those majors that are not open to transfer applicants (Art, Music, Dance, Nursing).

How do I become eligible for Honors to Honors?

- Contact your Community College Honors Program Director in the fall semester prior to transfer for information on how to be nominated for Honors to Honors.
- You must be confirmed by your Community College Honors Program Director as a member in good standing, and must successfully complete your Honors program requirements with a UC transferable GPA of 3.7 or higher by the end of the spring semester prior to transfer.
- Submit your UC Application to UC Irvine by December 1, 2025.
- Submit the Transfer Academic Update (TAU) by the January 31, 2026 priority deadline.
- Complete all transfer admission and major specific requirements by the end of the spring semester prior to transfer.
- If admitted with at least a 3.7 GPA and nominated by your honors staff, then you will be considered for the UC Irvine CHC.
- If invited to the CHC, students must fill out an additional form indicating commitment to the CHC
 program requirements and academic advising guidelines, after you submit your SIR to UC Irvine. You
 must maintain a minimum 3.7 UC transferable GPA and meet all deadlines in order to maintain your
 CHC eligibility.

Transfer Admission Guarantee (TAG)

- A TAG application is only needed for guaranteed admission for participating majors (see admissions.uci. edu/tag for participating majors). **TAG is not required for Honors to Honors consideration.**
