In computing your expenses, you should keep in mind that international students (F1 status/visa) are not allowed to work except in special circumstances, which must be authorized by the US Immigration Service. The amount of funds required for the academic year **2017-2018** is approximately \$23,426.00 (see below) based on a course load of 12 units (the minimum required for F1 visa students).
