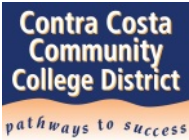

Definitions

College Outcome Allocation Framework:

A) SCFF Method: This allocation method is used when a student outcome can be clearly attributed to a single college. Based on SCFF metric definitions, such as the associate degree metric, it refers to the number of students who earned an associate degree during a given academic year. For example, any student who earns a degree only at CCC is counted as a CCC student.

B) SCFF + Enrollment ratio: This method is used when there is a tie on a metric across colleges. The student's outcome is split among the colleges based on enrollment. For example, the same type of degree is achieved at CCC and DVC with 40% of their enrollment at CCC and 60% at DVC, CCC receives 0.4 of the count and DVC receives 0.6.

Transfer Level Math and English. The split is always 50/50 when there is a tie between colleges.

Nine or More CTE. The count proportion is based on all CTE courses enrolled in that year.

Categories C and D include students who (1) appear in the CCCCO SCFF metric download as eligible for Supplemental or Student Success funding, and (2) whose eligibility for the SCFF metric cannot be validated using local data

C) Enrollment ratio Only: Student counts are allocated based solely on enrollment ratios, which reflect the proportion of coursework completed at each college. For example, if a student completed 20% of their enrollment at CCC, 20% at LMC, and 60% at DVC, their headcount would be allocated proportionally as 0.2 to CCC, 0.2 to LMC, and 0.6 to DVC

D) Home Location: If a student appears in the CCCCO SCFF metric download but has no local enrollment record, the student is assigned to a college based on their current home location

Supplemental

AB540 Students: Headcount of students by district who were granted an exemption from nonresident tuition pursuant to ECS 68130.5 in the district in the reporting year

Pell Grant Recipients: Headcount of students by district who received a Federal Pell Grant in the district in the reporting year

Promise Grant Recipients: Headcount of students by district who received a California College Promise Grant fee waiver pursuant to ECS 76300 in the district in the reporting year

Student Success Allocation

Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT): Headcount of students by district who were reported as receiving a Chancellor's Office approved associate degree for transfer (ADT) at the district in the reporting year and were reported with an enrollment at the district in the reporting year

Associate Degree: Headcount of students by district who were reported as receiving a Chancellor's Office approved associate degree at the district in the reporting year and were reported with an enrollment at the district in the reporting year and did not meet the criteria for the SCFF Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) metric

Credit Certificate: Headcount of students by district who were reported as receiving a Chancellor's Office approved credit certificate requiring the equivalent of 16 or more semester units at the district in the reporting year and were reported with an enrollment at the district in the reporting year and did not meet the criteria for the SCFF Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) metric, SCFF Associate Degree metric, or SCFF Baccalaureate Degree metric

Completion of Transfer Level: Headcount of students by district who successfully completed both a transfer-level mathematics course and a transfer-level English course with grades equivalent to C or better in the district during the academic year when first reported as non-special admit credit student

Successful Transfer to a Four-Year University: Headcount of students by district who earned the equivalent of 12 or more semester units in the district in the year prior to the reporting year and were not reported as enrolled at a California Community College in the reporting year and were reported as enrolled at a 4-year institution in the reporting year

Nine or More CTE Units: Headcount of students by district who successfully completed the equivalent of nine or more CTE units with grades equivalent to C or better within the district in the reporting year

Attainment of Regional Living Wage: Headcount of students by district who were enrolled in the district in the year prior to the reporting year, were not enrolled system-wide or at any transfer institution in the reporting year, and were reported as earning wages greater than or equal to the regional living wage for the district in the reporting year
