I am an adjunct instructor teaching Stat C1000 at the Brentwood and Pittsburg Campuses, where I joined the college in July 2026. Before teaching, I spent eighteen years leading data and analytics teams, and I hold an MA in statistics from Columbia.

Most part-time faculty at LMC spend their time in classrooms rather than in governance, and I am glad to take this on so that our perspectives are actively represented. Because I am new to the college, my primary goal is to learn where a part-time voice is missing. Two areas seem worth taking on from the start:

- 1. Governance Structures: Part-time faculty carry a substantial share of the college's teaching and a much smaller share of how it governs. I am interested in exploring where that gap is structural and where it is simply a matter of outreach.*
- 2. Committee Confirmations: Seats reserved for part-time faculty often go unfilled because the openings are not visible to us and no one makes the ask. I want to be a reliable point of contact for this: tracking open seats, finding part-time colleagues who want them, and helping them navigate the statement of interest process.*

Alongside this, I am committed to the core work of the seat: preparing for meetings, gathering input from part-time colleagues ahead of votes, and reporting back afterward. Given my professional background, I am also glad to be useful when discussions turn quantitative, whether that involves funding formulas or student completion data. I am available for the biweekly Monday meetings and prepared to serve the full two-year term. I look forward to meeting you all.
