The Senate President will be given 1.0 load for each semester they serve. The 1.0 load will be given as 100% reassigned time, unless otherwise negotiated between the Senate President and the College President.

The Senate Vice President shall be given a 0.15 load for each semester they serve, unless the position is filled by an adjunct instructor. An adjunct Senate Vice President would be paid a stipend equivalent to 0.15 of their full-time, equivalent to faculty load.
