

College teams participating in this unique program receive one year of ongoing support as they implement an SEM project of their choice. This year, we're aligning the SEM Program with Vision 2030, recent legislative changes, and the Student-Centered Funding Formula. All colleges are welcome to participate, regardless of previous involvement in the program.

Application window: January 29 – February 19, 2025

The 2025-26 cohort will accept **15 college teams**, each with the opportunity to:

- **Apply** a holistic approach to SEM that emphasizes retention and completion along the student journey.
- **Examine** and use data to inform SEM strategies.
- **Engage** with peer colleges to explore and implement promising practices.
- **Develop and launch** a tailored SEM project at your college.
- **Collaborate** with a designated team of coaches for guidance and support throughout the program.
- **Access** a wide range of resources through the CCCCCO's Vision Resource Center.

College teams will participate in three in-person convenings over the course of the year:

- **SEM Academy**, June 6-7, 2025 (located in the South)
- **Midpoint Convening**, January 15-16, 2026 (located in the North)
- **Final Convening**, May 15, 2026 (located in the South)
