The SST will focus on implementing the student success team model, approved by SGC in Spring 2023, with an eye on disproportionately impacted populations as noted in our Student Equity and Achievement Plan, first-year students, and online learners while including continuous clarification of a student's academic path. The group will focus its work on the initial interventions and milestones implemented by the Student Success Team through a Guided Pathways framework and explore potential integration with other initiatives including the Black Student Success Initiative.
