CSU-CCC Transfer Pathways Mapper Project Opening Session

The Office of the Chancellor invites campus teams to attend the CSU-CCC Transfer Pathways Mapper Project Opening Session on Thursday, March 26, 2020 at 9:30 am at the CSU Office of the Chancellor in Long Beach, CA.

The goals of the *Transfer Pathways Mapper Project* are to improve ADT pathways and increase the likelihood that a student will get to and through the CSU with an ADT pathway. To accomplish these goals, the project supports additional CCC-CSU partnerships focused on increasing intersegmental faculty engagement on ADT pathways, high-demand majors and developing a mobile/digital transfer mapper tool.

At the opening session, participants will:

- Learn about the efforts to strengthen intersegmental partnerships to improve transfer student success
- Learn about the digital transfer mapper tool development and implementation process, and hear first-hand from leaders at Bakersfield College who have implemented the digital tool
- Build relationships across campus departments, teams, and systems

The Opening Session will conclude with an opportunity for campus partners to work together and initiate next steps for the project.

Campus Teams

Each campus may send <u>up to five</u> people most directly involved in managing the various aspects of the *Transfer Pathways Mapper Project*, including coordinating meetings and communications with the CSU partner institution, mapping and approving program coursework to satisfy transfer requirements, and working with the technology vendor to translate the program maps and data into the digital tool. We recommend you consider the following roles:

- ➤ Administrator and Faculty Lead Provide overall project support and progress updates to key institutional stakeholders. Lead the project by scheduling meetings, following up on action items, and being a liaison for their faculty/staff participants and other constituents. Serve as the point of contact for CSU Office of the Chancellor.
- ➤ **Discipline Faculty** Facilitate the development of program maps in their discipline in coordination with discipline faculty from the CSU partner campus.



- ➤ *Advisor/Counselor* Provide transfer expertise from the student engagement perspective.
- ➤ Articulation/Transfer Officer Provide transfer expertise from a policy/articulation perspective.
- > Curriculum Expert Provide guidance on the formal curricular approval processes (curriculum committee chair, dean/AVP of academic programs, etc.).
- ➤ Institutional Research and Information Technology Representatives Provide guidance on institutional data and technological capabilities.
