



# **Academic Senate: Ethnic Studies/SJS Fall 2022 Update**

# History of ETHN Studies at LMC

- In 1990, LMC senate called for hiring Ethnic Studies faculty.
- In 2016, senate called again for an Ethnic Studies hire and a combined Ethnic Studies and Social Justice Studies Department.
- In 2019, Ethnic Studies trained faculty was hired to lead the SJS degrees and build the new ETHN program.
- District wide Ethnic Studies Council created in 2020 and endorsed in 2021
- Senate endorsed Ethnic Studies workgroup established in Sept. 2021
  - Ethnic Studies workshops here and across the district 2021-2022
  - Co-hosted ETHN speaker series
  - Multiple flex workshops
  - District-wide Ethnic Studies teach-in with hundreds of attendees
- Phase 1 and phase 2 of the new program endorsed (2021-2022)
- Construction of Area F classes (11 Ethnic Studies classes total)
- Department proposal and bylaws created (2022)
- Presented to SGC (2022)

# Timeline from All College Day, August 18, 2022

- Program approval from CCCCO's office- September/October (awaiting their memo)
- Box 2A for F/T faculty position for Ethnic Studies (October)
- Alignment of remaining courses to the proposed department sign MOU (September)
- Budget and GL development with Business Services (October/November)
- Final review by College President (November)
- New Department effective January 1, 2022

# Comparisons Across 4CD

- **CCC approved general Ethnic Studies Department, now housing the La Raza Studies and Africana Studies Departments.**
- **CCC has 3 Area F approved classes.**
- **DVC hired Ethnic Studies full-time faculty. Entering as the new Ethnic Studies Department chair and will build their new program.**
- **DVC has 1 Area F approved class.**
