Election for Academic Senate Officers – *Academic Senate President, At-Large Liberal Arts and Science Part Time, At-Large Student Services Part Time and At-Large Career and Technical Education Part-Time* will commence. Voting will close Tuesday, February 18th, 2020 at 5:00pm. Only votes received prior to the voting deadline will count. The election results will be reported during the Academic Senate meeting on February 24th, 2020.

Terms of Service

All Senate officers are elected to two-year terms. The Senate President may serve at most two consecutive terms. The position of President will have 100% reassigned time. Further description of the election, terms, payment, and duties and responsibilities associated with these positions can be located in the Academic Senate Bylaws. Call for Candidates - Academic Senate President (Term Begins Fall 2020)

Academic Senators of Los Medanos College may put themselves forward for the elected position of Academic Senate President. If you would like to run for this position, please submit a candidate statement via email to <u>MArcidiacono@losmedanos.edu</u> on or before December 13th, 2019. Please state clearly the position in which you are interested. Candidate statements must include the following: your name, the position sought, your current position on the Academic Senate (if seeking the position of President), and your current job title. Candidates will present to Academic Senate on February 3rd, 2020. **Please Note:** All potential Academic Senate President candidates are entitled to the following per the Academic Senate Bylaws: *"Candidates for either Senate President or Vice-President must be allowed to give a fifteen minute oral presentation to the Senate before the election if they choose, followed by a brief Q&A session. Each candidate may also provide all LMC faculty with an information sheet no more than two pages long, including testimonials."*

If you'd like to include an Information Sheet and/or more detailed Candidacy Statement for the February 3rd meeting it will not be due until January 29th, 2020. December 13th is the

deadline for the basic Candidate Statement to include: your name, the position sought, your current position on the Academic Senate (if seeking the position of President), and your current job title.
