8. Position Paper

9. eLumen Update

- Nikki provided an eLumen update using the computer to reveal the eLumen progress to date. Nikki
 explained and demonstrated the different workflow design, mainly the COOR component. The COOR data
 input project and quality checks will be completed by Sylvia and Office of Instruction personnel. This project
 will be completed by December 2019.
- Nikki shared the system is user friendly and scheduled to go live Fall 2020. With regards to the curriculum
 responsibility, the committee will need to develop a curriculum workflow, review existing forms, and align
 practices to the eLumen system. eLumen will become a course depository to review documents, moving
 the curriculum process from paper to electronic. Once the curriculum component is completed, the next
 phase will be assessment and program review.
