## 4. <u>GE Spring & Fall 2025 work: GE Handbook work/updates</u>

Committee members voice concern that changing the mapping of GE SLOs from the current model to "match" the new boxes would create additional confusion when the committee reviews courses. Currently, the committee identifies a pre-2020 model, the current model, and now the fall 2025 model.

Committee member suggest moving away from using numbers for GE SLOs and instead use the actual words for the SLOs.

Voting member also notes the importance of the fact that box residency does not dictate GE SLO mapping, and that many courses the committee assessed lately have been mapped outside of their residency box.

Advisory member suggests putting minimum unit requirement in parenthesis.

The committee discusses the idea of switching from numbered SLOs to using fully written out SLOs instead.

GE SLO Ethical insight
