5. Committee/Task Team Updates: Senate, SEM, TLC, CC, IDEA, and liberal Arts Task Team

Senate- President has been testing the idea of opening a position of Dean for DE and managing the Brentwood Center. Members noted that this position would require additional clarification. The senate had a change proposed to the Senate bylaws, which would allow adjunct faculty to represent designated areas in the Senate with approval from that area's full–time faculty. In response to this proposition, some GE committee members raised the question of whether the open part-time seats on the Senate shall be filled before any adjunct faculty could represent an empty full-time faculty seat. Another sentiment was that the results from the outgoing survey regarding Senate attendance would be a highly valuable tool in determining the level of involvement needed from both full-time and adjunct faculty.
