- We have Canvas training modules for your students.

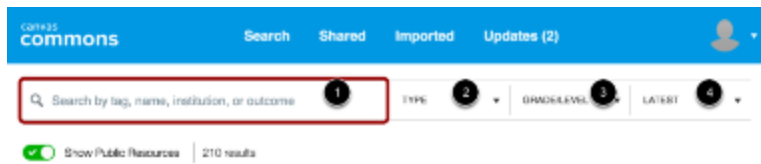
## HOW TO EMBED STUDENT TRAINING INTO YOUR COURSE SHELL

These are available for you to import into your class using the "Commons" function. Here's how you do that:

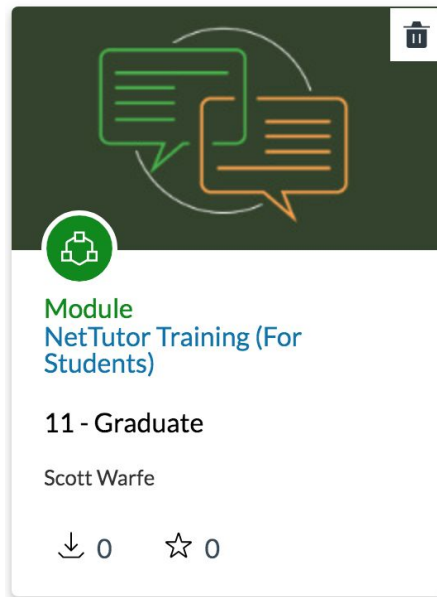
Step One: Select the "Commons" link on the far-left menu bar:
