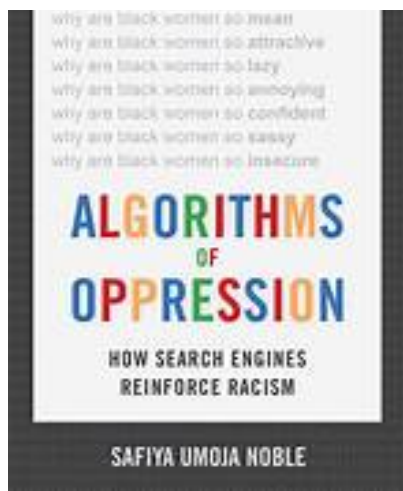

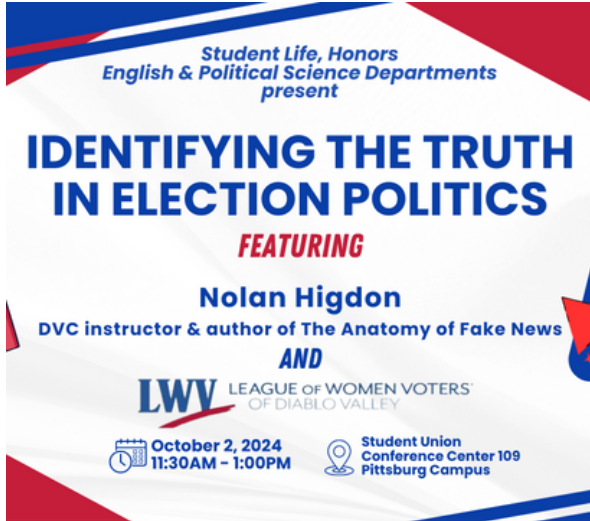

MESA is now the largest MESA program in the state. Great job!





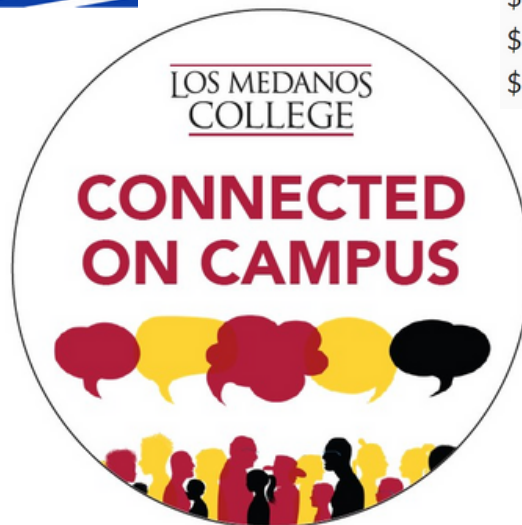
